With deep knowledge of Madagascar's history, culture, and architecture, Helianta expertly guides visitors through the rich past of Antananarivo. This tour is more than just sightseeing—it is an immersive journey into the stories behind historic landmarks, old neighborhoods, and cultural relics that define the city's heritage. As you walk, you'll also explore some of the city's iconic stairs, a key feature of Antananarivo's landscape built across many hills. Helianta shares fascinating insights into the evolution of the city, blending historical facts with engaging anecdotes. Whether it's the colonial architecture, sacred hills, or the royal palace, you'll experience the depth of Malagasy heritage from a local expert's perspective.

End your visit at the Musée de la Photographie, which has a thematic exposition about Tana history.

Starting point : Rasalama Temple, ambohimistimbina @ 9.30am

Ending point : Musée de la Photographie, Andohalo @ 11.00am
