Itinerary

Day 1. ANTANANARIVO – ANDASIBE 150km: Depart for Andasibe national Park. The drive can take about 4 hours and can already give you the glimpse of the asian landscape with its paddy fields, its architecture as well as the malagasy daily lifestyle. Short Stop at Marozevo to visit the reptile farm: Geckos, lizards, chameleons, snakes, frogs, bats, butterflies and lemurs can be seen there. Arriving in Andasibe, there is an option to make a first visit down the road after sunset to spot the nocturnal animals. In the afternoon, you are going to visit Vakona Private Reserve starting with the lemur's island where you can get familiar with the lemurs in the open area; great time to have fun with the lemurs.

Accommodation: Mantadia Lodge*** or similar

Day 2. VISIT ANALAMAZAOTRA NATIONAL PARK: Half day visit of Analamazaotra National Park. You can discover the animals in the wild, their natural habitat: the Indri indri and over 12 lemurs species, the black and white ruffed lemur, the Diademed Sifaka, the Brown Lemur, the Bamboo Lemur...

Accommodation: Mantadia Lodge***or similar

Day 3. ANDASIBE – AMBATONDRAZAKA: After breakfast, 4 hours-drive heading to Ambatondrazaka, the most important rice-growing region of Madagascar. This place is the last refuge for the critically endangered Bandro lemur, a species endemic to Madagascar. This unique primate can only be found in this specific habitat, highlighting the importance of conservation efforts to protect this fragile ecosystem.

Ambatondrazaka is a Malagasy city offering a unique blend of nature, culture, and local life. Situated on the shores of Lake Alaotra, it captivates visitors with its stunning lakeside landscapes and exceptional biodiversity. Its rich cultural heritage is evident in its ancestral traditions, local crafts, and colonial architecture. As a dynamic economic center, Ambatondrazaka plays a significant role in the region. This city is an ideal destination for travelers seeking authenticity and eager to discover the richness and diversity of Madagascar.

Accommodation: Bandro camp or similar

Day 4. VISIT OF BANDRO PARC: Our adventure begins at dawn with a canoe trip to spot the Bandro, a critically endangered lemur unique to Lake Alaotra. This elusive primate, also known as the Alaotra bamboo lemur, is a true treasure of Madagascar. Beyond its remarkable wildlife, Bandro Park plays a vital role in protecting the habitat of aquatic birds, amphibians, and other endemic species. By promoting sustainable ecotourism, the park contributes to the local economy while raising awareness about conservation and supporting neighboring communities.

Following the canoe trip, we can embark on a hike around the park to a scenic viewpoint, where we can admire the breathtaking landscape of the Alaotra region.

Bandro Park, located near Lake Alaotra in Madagascar, is vital for the protection of the bandro (Hapalemur alaotrensis), an endangered lemur species endemic to the area. It also preserves marsh ecosystems rich in biodiversity, supports sustainable ecotourism, and benefits local communities.

Accommodation: Bandro camp or similar

Day 5. AMBATONDRAZAKA – ANTANANARIVO: After breakfast, return to Antananarivo.
